For fans of WNUA who are lamenting the loss of the smooth jazz powerhouse, Barry White's guitar stylings, John Wynn's bass rumblings and Bobby Gordon's grooves will be music to your ears.

on Thursdays, the Juliano Gypsy Jazz group. Shows are June 18, 25 and July 2. Gypsy jazz (or jazz manouche) has a long history in Europe with its most famous progenitors being Django Reinhardt, Stéphane Grappelli and more recently Biréli Lagrène.

Originating in the Romani community of France in the 1930s, Gypsy jazz has spread to

all continents. In Chicago, Juliano Milo shares his brand of Gypsy jazz to Woodstock with original flair. He has won numerous awards in Yugoslavia and beyond for his accordion playing.

Jazz on the Square is a not-for-profit organization based in Woodstock, Illinois.

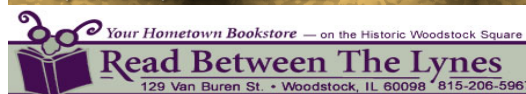
Our mission is to provide the best live jazz performance and education in northern Illinois.

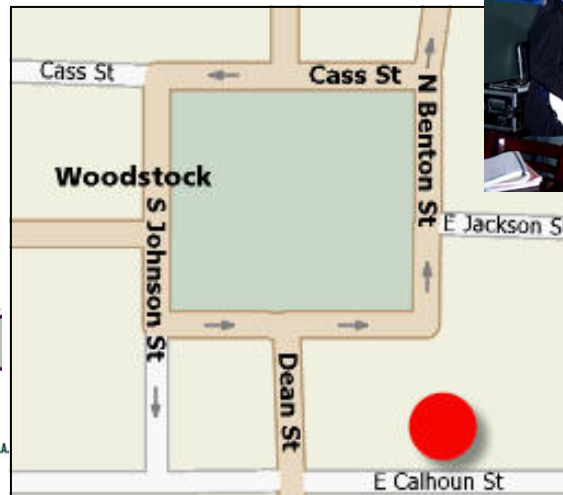
